ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- ❖ Approximately **25 cadets** are admitted **every six months**.
- ❖ Candidates should **not be less than 11½ years of age or must not have attained the age of 13** on 01 (Jan) or 01 (July) of the Term they join in.
- ❖ Admissions are made to **Class VIII only**. The candidate must be studying in Class VII or have passed Class VII from a recognized school at the time of joining.
- ❖ Application forms are to be submitted to the respective **State Governments**. Candidates are selected on the **basis of their performance in an All India Entrance Examination** held twice a year comprising a written examination of question papers in
 - ❖ **English (125 Marks)**
 - ❖ **Mathematics (200 Marks)**
 - ❖ **General Knowledge (75 Marks)**
- ❖ **Successful candidates are called for Viva-Voce test (50 marks)**

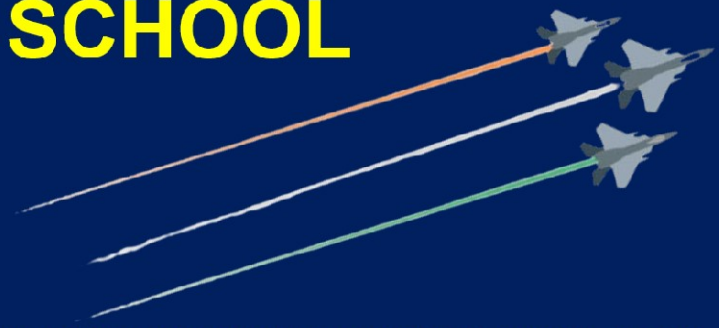

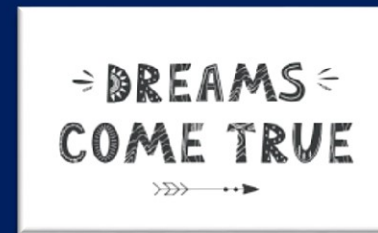
