We reached Kanpur on 3rd August 2025 (evening). Teams from Delhi, Kanpur, Pune, and Chennai zones also participated. Our school comes under the Chennai Avadi Zone.

The inauguration ceremony took place on 4th August evening with the traditional lamp lighting. Due to heavy rain, the indoor events were scheduled first, and the outdoor events commenced the following day.

We are proud of our students' spirited performances and sportsmanship throughout the championship.



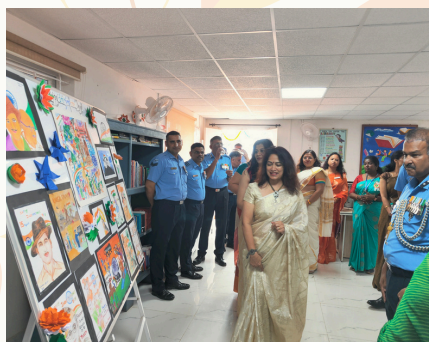
CCA Activities:

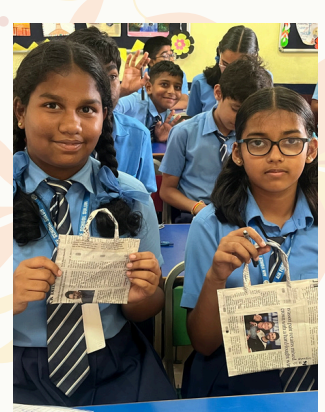
APPROVAL OF SENIOR SECONDARY AFFILIATION

CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT FOR CLASSES 1 AND 2

For Classes 1 and 2, CA was conducted during 4th week August which focuses on observation, oral work, class activities, storytelling, and project-based tasks. It helps teachers identify strengths and weaknesses early, provide timely feedback, and support individual learning needs. Through worksheets, group activities, and simple quizzes, students are encouraged to participate actively and develop confidence. Continuous Assessment also reduces exam stress, promotes joyful learning, and builds a strong foundation for future studies by emphasizing understanding, creativity, and regular progress monitoring.
