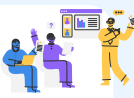

The Onam celebration by students was truly memorable and left everyone with festive cheer in their hearts.





MILAD-UN-NABI CELEBRATION: A GRACEFUL TRIBUTE BY OUR YOUNG STARS

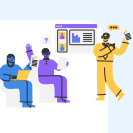
Hindi Diwas Celebration (8th – 12th September) 🕯️

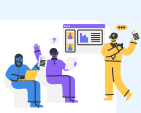

Half Yearly Examination 2025

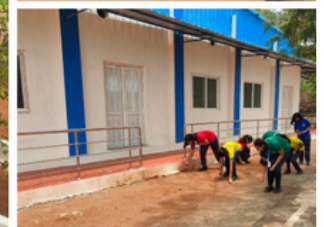
